## **INTRODUCTION:**

Standard texts of anatomy and embryology discuss urogenital development. However, the subjects are often discussed briefly, and key elements of anatomy and development may be glossed over. These presentations expand existing knowledge and seeks to add new details that may otherwise be missed or unknown.

Thesemchapters detail the anatomy and development of the *male and female urogenital system*.

The developmental anatomy of the *trigone of the bladder and urethra* in both sexes is explained.

Concepts in the development of the *ureter* and *congenital anomalies of the ureter* are presented.

Development of the male external genitalia, male urethra/vestibule, fossa navicularis (glanular urethra), glans penis and the external urethral meatus, is detailed.
