8b. FEMALE URETHRA, VESTIBULE - terminology

Female urethra:

Bladder neck, glandular urethra, membranous urethra.

Vestibule:

PERINEAL PARTS:

Posterior section, under colliculus feminalis (CF). Introitus of vagina and openings of distal ends of Gartner's ducts, are on ventral surface of CF.

Middle section, under distal urethral meatus and area proximal to suspensory ligament of the clitoris. Posterior and middle sections of the vestibule are equivalent to the bulbar urethra PHALLIC PART:

Anterior section, under pars intermedia, (under bicavernosal body in glans clitoris, equivalent to fossa navicularis in the male. Penile urethra is not represented in the female vestibule.

Outlet of the vestibule: Inner surfaces of the folds of, the posterior commissure of the labia minora (fourchette), labia minora in the perineum, labia minora (frenulum) of the clitoris, and anterior commissure of the labia minora/frenulum.
